Assembly Instructions

To Assemble

Step 1: Separate the 12 stems into 3 piles according to the hole location. [SEE FIGURE 1]

Step 2: Take 4 stems with the same hole location and slide them onto a limb.

Step 3: Spread the stems along the limbs, 2 on each side of the center hole on the limb.

Step 4: Repeat that process for all limbs and stems.

Step 5: Put a flat washer onto the bolt

Step 6: Holding the bolt upside down (threads up), slide each limb onto the bolt, starting with the limb with the lowest stems first, then the middle, then the highest. *[SEE FIGURE 2]*

Step 7: Spread the limbs out into a star pattern.

Step 8: Layer each of the U-Brackets onto the bolt, putting each bracket in each of the spaces made by the limbs. *[SEE FIGURE 3]* (The limbs make a star and the weight makes a star) *[SEE FIGURE 4]*

Step 9: Hand tighten the nut until there's about an inch of the bolt showing.

Step 10: Adjust the stem spacing to your liking.

Install and Go Fishing!

Step 11: "Fluff the Leaves" by bending the splits of the limbs back against themselves

Step 12: Place Grass Beds in 2-3' of water in areas of no-little current.
